Student/Parent Visit

The parent tour, interview, and student visits begin in September and continue until Wooster School's Application Deadline of February 1, 2021. Please contact the Admission Office to arrange for these visits. After February 1, 2021 we will move to a rolling admission as space is available.

We require that the Parent Online Application Form and fee be submitted prior to the day of the student visit.

Application Deadline

Applicants who complete their paperwork by the February 1, 2021, deadline will be notified of the admission decision on or before February 28, 2021. Families are urged to apply as early as possible. Late applicants are encouraged to apply and will be considered as their files become complete.

Variable Tuition Application

Families interested in applying for variable tuition must complete the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS), available online at sssbynais.org/parents. This completed form must be submitted online to the School and Student Services (SSS) no later than February 1, 2021. Other paperwork, such as W-2 Wage and Tax Statements and federal income tax returns, must also be submitted by that time. Self-employed must submit business taxes. In cases of divorce or separation, both biological and/or adoptive parent/guardian households are required to submit all paperwork.
